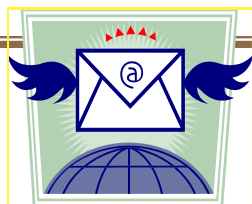
NEW FORMS NOW IN USE!

After consulting with an attorney, the JWC Board of Directors recently updated the adult background screening policy. As a result, in our best-effort attempt to protect you the volunteer, our candidates, and the organization, we now have new screening forms and registration forms. This has also resulted in TWO new work applications—one for adults (over age 18) and one for minors (under age 18).

All volunteers (servant-"workers") over the age of 18 are required to complete this new form once every THREE YEARS. Please read the form carefully and complete BOTH pages of the form. Please submit a

new background check form with your next work request, regardless of when you last filled out a background check. Please download the new form from the JWC website (www.JourneyWithChrist.org).

Please start using the new adult (over 18 years old) and minor (under 18 years of age) work requests immediately. You may download these forms from the JWC website. Please be sure to READ THE ENTIRE FORM CAREFULLY and complete BOTH pages of the form. Please contact the registrar if you have any questions.

JOURNEY WITH CHRIST STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through Him all things were made. For us and for our salvation He came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit He became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate; He suffered death and was buried. On the third day He rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and His kingdom will have no end. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

With this as the foundation of our faith, we proclaim:

- We believe in the inspired Word of God, as our authority of faith and practice.
- We believe in the Trinity. One God manifested in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. God is our Father, Creator and Sustainer of life. Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He is the only way to the Father because of His unique birth, life, death, resurrection, and ascension. The Holy Spirit is equally God whose ministry is to convict, indwell and empower every Christian.
- We believe man (Genesis 5:1-2) was created in God's image, but through Adam's fall, we inherit a sin nature. Personal salvation is attained only through the acceptance of Jesus Christ as Savior. Discipleship, growth, and accountability in Christ are necessary for every believer.
- We believe that God's prevenient, justifying, and sanctifying grace which draws us into divine relationship, must be claimed as an act of faith, and is perfected through the power of the Holy Spirit. Baptism and Communion are the outward and visible signs of this inward and spiritual grace.
- We believe in the local church. We believe that the local church is Christ's witness to the world. We support the local church by nurturing and encouraging dedicated Christian leaders by promoting unity, inspiration, and fellowship with Christ.
