Seasons of Plenty and Drought

I am currently 39 weeks and 3 days pregnant; four days from my due date. Before he arrives, I reflect back on the season of life I have experienced while growing this miracle inside me.

My husband and I have experienced a season of plenty. We purchased a new home, celebrated 5 years of marriage and hit a few other significant milestones. We recognize that these things would not be possible without the outpouring of love and blessing from God and from those He has placed in our lives: the body of Christ.

My season is about to change with the birth of my son, Connor. It will likely be a different kind of "plenty", but may have moments of drought. With all the change that is about to occur, I know that God and my brothers and sisters in Christ still walk with me, even through what feels like a drought.

The Journey community has experienced a different kind of season as well. We were

excited to enter 2018 with a full slated Board of Directors and expectant possibilities. However, 2018 was peppered with challenges and disappointments including cancelling a number of Journeys and struggling to find Directors.

As a Board, we have struggled with difficult questions: Does God still walk with this ministry or does he have another plan? Where do we go from here? How do we best meet the needs of the ministry?

We know the power of the Journey with Christ and that many in this body of Christ are committed to this ministry. In times of drought, the community must rally to sustain that which we value. God acts through his people, a lesson we learn over and over on every Journey. God stirs in the hearts of Cats and servants through the words and actions of His followers.

It is in this season of drought, we need the words and action of the community to sustain us! That means you.

Prayer is always the best and first place to start. Pray for the direction of the ministry and the Board that leads it.

After prayer, take the next step and turn prayer into action in a way that works for you. Talk to those in the community you think would be Spirit-led Directors. Nominate them if they have interest.

Speak to others about the need to sponsor cats. Sponsor cats when you can!

Be engaged in the conversation. Read the Flight Report and communicate with the board regarding your ideas or concerns..

Create relationships or continue relationships with cats that have attended. Invite them back to work. If there are barriers or challenges, reach out to other community or the board for support.

We cannot do this alone and we cannot "fix" the challenges we face without the action and support of the entire community.

I look forward to hearing from you and I am excited about the ways 2019 can be ushered in as a season of plenty.

Luke 10:2 says "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few." Go and be laborers so that we may reap a bountiful harvest!

As a result, in our best-effort attempt to protect you the volunteer, our candidates, and the organization, we now have new screening forms and registration forms. This has also resulted in TWO new work applications.

Please start using the new [Adult \(18+\)](#) and [Minor \(under 18\)](#) work requests immediately.

All servant "workers" over the age of 18 are required to complete an [Adult Background Screening Form](#) once every THREE YEARS. Please read the form carefully and complete BOTH pages of the form. Please submit a new background check form with your next work request, regardless of when you last filled out a background check.

Statement of Faith

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through Him all things were made. For us and for our salvation He came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit He became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate; He suffered death and was buried. On the third day He rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and His kingdom will have no end. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

With this as the foundation of our faith, we proclaim:

- We believe in the inspired Word of God, as our authority of faith and practice.
- We believe in the Trinity. One God manifested in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. God is our Father, Creator and Sustainer of life. Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He is the only way to the Father because of His unique birth, life, death, resurrection, and ascension. The Holy Spirit is equally God whose ministry is to convict, indwell and empower every Christian.
- We believe man (Genesis 5:1-2) was created in God's image, but through Adam's fall, we inherit a sin nature. Personal salvation is attained only through the acceptance of Jesus Christ as Savior. Discipleship, growth, and accountability in Christ are necessary for every believer.
- We believe that God's prevenient, justifying, and sanctifying grace which draws us into divine relationship, must be claimed as an act of faith, and is perfected through the power of the Holy Spirit. Baptism and Communion are the outward and visible signs of this inward and spiritual grace.
- We believe in the local church. We believe that the local church is Christ's witness to the world. We support the local church by nurturing and encouraging dedicated Christian leaders by promoting unity, inspiration, and fellowship with Christ.
